Requirements:

- * School uniform to be worn on day 1.
- * Tidy casual clothing may be worn at other times.
- * Personal bathroom requisites (shampoo, toothpaste, etc).
- * Sleeping bag, pillow, sheets (optional), bath towel
- * Raincoat or parka.
- * A small carry bag for personal items (eg money) to be taken onto the coach. This will include Tuesday's packed recess, lunch & afternoon snack which is to be brought from home. Soft drinks ARE NOT PERMITTED.
- * A note from parents, detailing any special needs, medicines.

- * iPods and cameras may be brought along at own risk (the school is not responsible and will not investigate damaged, lost or stolen items).
